The flight was sponsored by the Blount County Historical Society and included Veterans of the Korean and Vietnam wars. Rosebud Marilyn Myrick Drake was invited to go as Mabel's guardian.

A total of 177 Veterans, guardians, flight crew assistants and media made the trip.

The first stop was The Tomb of the Unknowns at Arlington Cemetery then on to the memorials honoring Veterans of WWII, US Air Force, US Marines, Korean

War, Iowa Jima, Vietnam as well as the FDR memorial. When returning to Blount County at midnight, the buses were met with a large parade of Blount County citizens. It was a great honor for Mabel and Marilyn to make this trip with the Veterans of Korea and Vietnam.
