#### 2023 Convention How-To Information

CONVENTION REGISTRATION: You may either mail the form on page 3 with your check, OR register online at www.rosietheriveter.net. Registrations received after May 10, 2023 and "walk-ins" who have not pre-registered can only be accepted on a space-available basis. If you must cancel your registration, requests for reimbursement must reach Stephanie Davis at the address on page 3 by May 27, 2023.

HOTEL INFORMATION: Special room rates are available at the Convention hotel, the Portland Marriott Downtown Waterfront, 1401 SW Naito Parkway, Portland, OR 97201. Reservations can be made <u>now</u> at this dedicated web address: https://book.passkey.com/go/RTRC6823, or by calling 1-800-546-9513. Cancellations require 72 hours notice.

Be sure to say you are with the American Rosie the Riveter Association Convention to get the special ARRA rate of \$179 per night, plus taxes and fees. This rate will apply to Thursday night, June 8, 2023 through Monday night, June 12, 2023.

The hotel has a limited number of accessible rooms. If you need an accessible room, make your reservation early, and be sure to state that you need one.

Please note that hotel rooms in the area fill up very quickly for the Portland Rose Festival weekend, so make your hotel reservation now, even if you are still in the process of making all your travel plans.

TRANSPORTATION AND PARADE INFORMATION: The hotel does not operate a shuttle from the airport. However, taxis are available for around \$45.00. Lyft and Uber ride-share services are also available. If you are driving, valet parking is available at the hotel, with unlimited come-and-go access during the day, for \$49 per day. Self-parking options are available within a block of the hotel for \$29 and up, but require that you pay each time you enter.

You will not need a car during the Convention. On Saturday, a bus will take Rosies to the parade staging area. The Rosie float is accessible and has safety rails. Helpers will be onsite. The bus will take everyone else to the Coliseum, where we will enjoy pre-parade festivities, then watch the floats as they parade right through the Coliseum. The bus will return everyone to the hotel.
