the Portland Rose Festival and Grand Floral Parade. The Rose Festival Foundation created a spectacular float (left) for our Rosies, while the Boeing company sponsored the float and walked in the parade with us.

The Foundation invited the Rosies to Thursday's military

reception that they host traditionally as part of Portland's Fleet Week festivities. Ships from the U.S. Navy, U.S. Coast Guard, and Royal Canadian Navy were in town. Our Rosies were honored guests as they met military brass and received a standing ovation from attendees, and it was announced that the Rosies would be the parade's Grand Marshals!

At our Friday Open House the room was packed, as convention participants, four TV channels, and the community honored our Rosies, gave gifts, and took photos. There was

enough electricity in that room to power the universe!

On Saturday, our Rosies looked splendid, arrayed

on their beautiful float. They received another standing ovation from parade participants and attendees as they passed through the Veteran's Memorial Coliseum to begin the parade, and the parade route was


novel, *Hotel Laguna*, is about a young woman who moved to CA to build WWII bombers, and follows her story after the war ended.




ings (left), Rosebud Ramble get-togethers, and writing letters and cards to hundreds of Rosies and veterans. The Chapter expanded three existing Rosie
