All Rosies Awarded Congressional Gold Medal

Wrap-up by Past National President, Dr. Yvonne Fasold (Rosebud 1, OR)



On April 10, 2024, the Congressional Gold Medal was awarded to all WWII Rosies, those living and those deceased. This medal is the highest civilian award in the U. S. given by Congress. It was my honor to be present at the ceremony, honoring my mother, my inspirational Rosie role models, and all of these remarkable women and their service to our country.

Twenty-seven original Rosies from across the country, ages 89 to 106, were present in Emancipation Hall at the U. S. Capitol in Washington, D. C. to represent the 6 million women who worked on the home front in WWII. forefront of efforts that lasted for many years to gain enough support in Congress. The award was signed into law in 2020.

It was all a whirlwind, but I came away with great memories! Thank you to all who helped make this whole experience happen."


birthday, and even took up jewelry-making! Happy Birthday!


program for Birchwood Women's Association, the Petoskey Sunrise Rotary Club (below), and at ARRA's own National Convention in Nashville.
